

ORDINANCE NO. 26, 2026

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE FRED A. NEMANN COMPANY FOR THE TOWER & WASHINGTON AVENUES IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of St. Bernard finds it necessary and in the best interest of the Village to authorize the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract with the Fred A. Nemann Company for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the project known as the Tower & Washington Avenues Improvements project.

Section 2. The Director of Public Safety and Service is hereby directed and authorized to enter into a contract with the Fred A. Nemann Company in the amount of \$2,026,706.53. The project portion to be paid by the Greater Cincinnati Water Works is \$1,307,243.70. The project portion to be billed to the Village is \$719,462.83.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is to enter into this contract as soon as possible to complete the Tower & Washington Avenues Improvements project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two-thirds of the members of said Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than a majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
